DECISION OF EPA PUNJAB UNDER REGULATION 12 OF REVIEW OF IEE AND EIA REGULATIONS, 2000 READ WITH SECTION 12 OF PUNJAB ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1997 REGARDING PROJECT "CONSTRUCTION OF MS ISP INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY, AT 18-KM SHEIKHUPURA FANS ABAD ROAD, SERVICE INDUSTRIES, SHEIKHUPURA."

1. Description of Project: Construction of MS ISP Integrated Waste Management Facility (Non Hazardous Waste), over an area of 08 acres with the capacity to convert organic waste into compost 30 tons / day.
2. Location of Project: 18-km Sheikhupura Faisalabad Road, Service Industries, District Sheikhupura.
3. Date of receiving of IEE 16.06.2020
4. After careful review of Initial Environment Examination (IEE) report, consideration of Site Inspection Report submitted by Deputy Director (Environment), Sheikhupura vide his letter No. F-15710DE/S&P/2020 dated 05.09.2020 and in pursuance of the recommendation of the committee of Experts made in the meeting thereof held on 16.09.2020, pursuant of other relevant record, Environmental Protection Agency, Punjab provisionally accords Environmental Approval under Regulation 12 of Review of IEE and EIA Regulations, 2000 read with Section 12 of Punjab Environmental Protection Act, 1997 for construction of your aforesaid project subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The Proponent shall ensure compliance with Punjab Environmental Quality Standards (PEQS);
 - ii. Mitigation Measures suggested in the Environmental report and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) shall be strictly adhered to for minimize any negative impacts on soil, ground water, air and biological resources of the Project area;
 - iii. The Proponent shall maintain record of the available measures taken for implementation of Environmental Management Plan for periodical verification by EPA, Punjab;
 - iv. Monitoring shall be carried out during the entire period of the Project activities. Monitoring reports shall be submitted to EPA Field office on quarterly basis;
 - v. The Proponent shall ensure that energy consumption shall be reduced by incorporating green energy sources along with regular power supply;
 - vi. The Proponent shall address the objections / concerns of neighbors / stakeholders on priority basis (if any at any stage);
 - vii. The Proponent shall obtain No Objection Certificates' clearance of all other concerned departments before commencement of work and will not start operations without obtaining necessary NOCs/Approvals;
 - viii. The proponent shall submit copies of all necessary NOCs/Approval from other concerned departments along with application for operational phase under Regulation 14 of IEE and EIA regulation 2000;
 - ix. The Proponent shall plant 5000 trees of 4-7 feet height of indigenous species in the district in consultation with Directorate of (EDD) / Deputy Director (Environment), Sheikhupura, within six months. The Proponent shall also take measures for protection and upkeep of these trees and shall maintain their proper record for verification by EPA;
 - x. The proponent shall follow building by Laws and the construction plan approved by the competent authority including seismic, structural and geotechnical analysis;
 - xi. The proponent shall install standby power generator, if required by adopting sound proofing techniques and it shall be equipped with chimney with proper height to discharge the hot gases / smoke;
 - xii. Compensation shall be provided to the inhabitants in case of loss of agricultural land, crop, property, etc. in accordance with the rules that are signed upon, as per Law. All conflicting issues regarding compensation, etc. should be settled amicably before the start of the Project activities with the approval of competent authority by involving all stakeholders;
 - xiii. The Proponent shall install wastewater Treatment facility to ensure compliance with PEQS;
 - xiv. Proper disposal of wastewater after treatment into existing sewer Sewerage system NOC issued by concerned Department;
 - xv. The Proponent shall provide latest PPEs (according to international best practices) to the workers;
